## Sweden's Carnegie Calls Rain for Canada's Ro-Sham-Bo Fire

Carnegie, a mixed team with 100% Worlds veterans from prior Open, Women & Junior's divisions, finished the day with a decisive win over Vancouver Canada's Ro-Sham-Bo.

The Swedes' strong throws and confident teamwork took them quickly to a halftime lead of 9-3. "They scored almost at will", said the volunteer scorekeeper.

Then Ro-Sham got the juice and answered with four scores in a row, two by #2.

"It's our first tournament together," explained Carnegie captain Stefan, "but we've been practicing twice a week for months." The practice showed, when Carnegie's impressive hucks to both women and men put an end to Ro-Sham's short run. At 16 - 8, Ro-Sham managed to recover a crazy huck, prolonging Sweden's win with one more score. But the Vancouverites couldn't capitalize on a Swedish goal line error in the next point, quickly turning the disc over in the wind. With a smooth upwind backhand to Bjorn Johansson, Sweden ended decisively, 17-9. A chippy game from the start, the spirit in this game had its own story. Punctuated early on by stomps and an exclamation or two, fortunately unrecognizable to most bystanders, this perhaps peripheral, perhaps integral other "game" had its own turning point.

At 14-7, Carnegie picked up a turnover.

The Swedes' #21 raced wide open toward the end zone on a fast break. A pick near the disc was called. Most play stopped, while he sped on. Then, as the deep threat noticed the stoppage of play and began to slow, a small cluster of bystanders heard him exclaim, "Ooohh, oohh, ooh", with a wry, crowd-pleasing smile. Nary a stomp was seen, nor exclamations heard, for the remainder of the game. The two teams came together in laughter for the post-game huddle.

Thus, the game came to a sportsmanlike end, with Carnegie's disco medley and Ro-Sham's MVP presentation to Carnegie's #14 who, "on the last point, called a foul on himself, despite our own turnover", and to #12, "the one who gave us a run for our money". To extend the frivolity, Ro-Sham taught Carnegie the looking game, ending the day with a 4-way win of their own.

Look out tomorrow for a talented, crisp, ambitious and strong Carnegie. Their combination of 12-year vets and up-coming former junior champions should give any top team an excellent game.
